2. The applicant has been convicted for the offence punishable under Sections 353 and 341 of the Indian Penal Code and sentenced to suffer rigorous imprisonment for six months and directed to pay total fine of Rs.1000/-.

3. The trial Court has suspended the execution of substantive sentences of imprisonment until filing of the appeal. It

will take time for the appeal to come up for hearing. In view of quantum of sentence, the execution of substantive sentence of imprisonment to stand suspended, pending the appeal.

4. The applicant be released on bail on his executing P. R. bond in the sum of Rs.15,000/- (Rupees Fifteen Thousand) with surety bond in the like amount.

5. The criminal application stands disposed of.
