3. The petitioners have made a grievance that the order passed by the Mamlatdar U/Sec. 5(2) of the said Act, which is impugned before the revisional authority, is to be executed on 08th July, 2022.

4. In these circumstances, this petition is disposed off permitting the petitioners to file an application for interim relief/interim stay before the revisional authority and seek orders from the revisional authority.
