PER COURT:-

1. Mr. Tandale, learned counsel for respondent nos.2 and 3 states that, pursuant to the order dated 15.02.2022 passed by this Court, the respondent nos.2 and 3 have already called for explanation of the petitioners and considering the explanation rendered by the petitioners would pass appropriate order as directed by the said order dated 15.02.2022 within a period of three weeks from today. The statement made by the learned counsel for respondent nos.2 and 3 is accepted as an undertaking to this Court.
