7. The appellant / Insurance Company is also permitted to withdraw the amount as mentioned in paragraph 7 of the compromise terms Article-"X".
8. The Court fee refund certificate be issued as per the provisions under the Maharashtra Court Fees Act, 1959.
9. The Civil Application/ s if any, stand/s disposed of.
