PER COURT :

1. Mr Tapan Sant, learned counsel for the applicant seeks leave to make corrections in para Nos. 1 to 7 to the extent of going abroad for fixing the schedule of wedding ceremony for his son. Leave granted.

3. Heard Mr Sant, learned counsel for the applicant, Mr Sanap, learned APP for the State and Mr Patale, learned counsel for Union of India/Respondent Nos. 3 and 4.
4. Mr Patale, learned counsel for respondent Nos. 3 and 4/Union of India and Mr Sanap, learned APP for the State/Respondent No.2 have no objection to grant permission as prayed by the applicant.
