2. The applicant is seeking condonation of delay of 3502 days. The delay appears to be caused due to his financial crisis. The learned AGP as well as the learned counsel for the acquiring body strongly opposed the application on the ground that the delay is not properly explained.

any interest for the aforesaid period of delay.
