PER COURT:-

1. This is a civil application for condonation of delay of two (02) days in filing second appeal.
2. Heard learned counsel Mr. Kanawade for the applicant and learned counsel Mr. Mandlik for the respondent.
3. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that delay of two (02) days in filing second appeal is not intentional, it is because of the communication gap between the party i.e. the applicant and his advocate.
