. It is an application for condonation of delay moved by the applicant/insurance company.

2 Heard Mr. Upadhye, learned counsel for applicant/insurance company, Mr. Tandale, learned counsel for respondent Nos.1 and 2. Respondent No.3 though duly served with notice, remained absent.

3 There seems to be delay of 263 days in preferring the appeal.

4 Mr. Tandale, learned counsel for respondent Nos.1 and 2 opposed to condone the delay.

5 Having regard to the nature of dispute between the parties and for the reasons stated in the application for condonation of delay,

paragraphs 3 and 4, the delay needs to be condoned in the interest of justice. Hence, the following order is passed:
