PER COURT:-

1. The father of the petitioner passed away on 25.01.2020. He was a permanent peon in respondent no.4 School. The petitioner moved an application on 25.02.2020 seeking compassionate appointment. He has now completed Diploma in Pharmacy and can be appointed to the post of Laboratory Assistant. A representation put forth by the petitioner dated 30.11.2021 is pending.
