1. Heard learned Counsel for the parties.
2. At the outset, the order impugned does not require interference of this Court under Article 227 of the Constitution of India. Learned counsel, on instructions, seeks to withdraw the petition. The petition stands dismissed as withdrawn.
3. However, the issue of valuation of the suit for the purpose of court fees and jurisdiction is kept open.
