1. Heard the learned counsel for the
applicant and the learned AGP for the
respondents/State.

2. The learned counsel for the applicant
submits that as per the order of the learned
Registrar (Judicial) dated 03-07-2018, the
applicant has removed office objections, then
also, the registration of the appeal is refused
by the learned Registrar (Judicial) by order
dated 03-07-2018. It appears from the record

that the applicant had filed an application for extension of one week time for removing the office objections dated 17-07-2018, and it was granted. It appears that during the period of 17-07-2018 to 19-07-2018 the applicant has removed all the office objections then also registration is refused.
