Order in Civil Application for condonation of delay

1. These are the applications for condonation of delay moved

2. Heard Mr. Morampalle, learned AGP for the applicants/ State and Mr. P.C. Mayure, learned counsel for the respondents / claimants.

3. For the reasons stated in the application for condonation of delay in para Nos. 2 to 4, the delay needs to be condoned to decide the appeals on its own merits.
