PER COURT :

1. These are the applications for condonation of delay moved by the applicants/State.
2. Heard Mr S.N. Morampalle, learned AGP for the applicants/State and Mr P.C. Mayure, learned counsel for the respondents/claimants.
3. Mr P.C. Mayure, learned counsel for the original claimants strongly opposed to condone the delay.

4. Mr S.N. Morampalle, learned AGP for the State/appellant submitted that the delay is not intentional. The delay was resulted due to completing formalities and obtaining sanction from the competent authority. He therefore, urged to condone the delay.
