PER COURT :

1. These are the applications for condonation of delay moved by the appellant/acquiring body.
2. Heard Mrs Kalpalata Patil - Bharaswadkar, learned Advocate for appellant/acquiring body, Mr M.R. Malpani holding for Mr A.B. Kale, learned Advocate for respondents/original claimants.

3. Mr Malpani, learned Advocate for the respondents/original claimants strongly opposed to condone the delay.
4. On perusing the record, it is seen that there is 1793 days delay in preferring the appeals by the acquiring body.
5. For the reasons stated in the application in paragraph 3, the delay needs to be condoned in the interest of justice.
