4. The applicants are also allowed to withdraw their 25% respective amounts of the deposited amount along with the accrued interest thereon by furnishing solvent surety / security to the satisfaction of learned Registrar (Judicial) of this Court.

5. The remaining amounts be invested in the F.D.R. in any Nationalized Bank till final disposal of these appeals.

6. The applications are accordingly disposed of.
