ORDER :

1. The applicant apprehends his arrest in connection with Crime No.0906 of 2022 registered with Newasa Police Station, District Ahmednagar for the offences punishable under sections 307, 143, 144, 147, 148, 323, 504, 506 of the Indian Penal Code.

2. Heard the learned advocate for the applicant and the learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the respondent State. Perused the investigation papers.

3. Similarly situated co-accused, i.e. accused No.1 is granted anticipatory bail in Anticipatory Bail Application No. 1565 of 2022, the applicant therefore deserves protection on the ground of parity. For the reasons stated in Anticipatory Bail Application No. 1565 of 2022, the application is allowed.

4. In the event of arrest of applicant in connection with Crime No.906 of 2022, registered with Newasa Police Station, District Ahmednagar for offences punishable under sections 307, 143, 144, 147, 148, 323, 504, 506 of the Indian Penal Code, the applicant shall be released on bail on executing PB and SB of Rs.15,000/-, with one surety in the like amount.

5. Till filing of the charge sheet, the applicant shall attend the concerned police station as and when called by the investigating officer and co-operate in the investigation. The applicant shall not tamper the prosecution evidence.
