ORDER:-

1. Heard the rival submissions. All the respective applicants are seeking condonation of delay as mentioned in their respective applications. The delay appears to be caused due to their financial crisis.

2. The learned A.G.P. as well as learned Counsel appearing for the Acquiring Body strongly opposed the applications on the ground that delay is not properly explained.
