1. These applications are for seeking condonation of delay of 2356 days caused in filing appeal seeking for enhancement of compensation amount.

2. Learned AGP for the respondents-State has objected for condonation of delay.
3. The applicants have stated the reasons for delay in para 4 to 6 of the applications. Besides that, it is submitted that though the award was dated 08.04.2013, however, the compensation amount has been deposited on 12.09.2019. It is submitted that due to paucity of funds, the applicants were not in a position to take expeditious steps.
