- 1.** Heard Mr. S. Malik, learned Counsel for the applicant.
- 2.** This is an application seeking condonation of delay to challenge the Registrar's order dated 11.01.2019 dismissing the applicant's Writ Petition for non-prosecution.
- 3.** Mr. Malik has pointed out that the applicant was appearing in person and on account of hypertension could not pursue the matter with diligence.
