1. Heard learned counsel for the parties.

2. In this case, respondent no.12 has expired. The present applications are filed seeking condonation of delay and leave to bring on record the legal representatives of deceased respondent no.12, if necessary, by setting aside abatement.

Substantial reasons have been set out in the applications and consequently sufficient cause is shown to condone the delay and to allow these applications.
