1] The learned counsel for the Petitioner submits that order has been passed by the Mamlatdar under Section 5 of the Mamlatdar Court's Act, 1906 for removal of obstruction. Thereafter, the Mamlatdar has also directed the Police Inspector, Vita Police Station, to give police protection for implementation of the order. The Petitioner, thereafter, approached the Police Station, however, police protection is not yet provided. The Petitioner is ready to deposit the amount as may be directed.

3] In case the application is filed by the Petitioner pursuant to the orders of Mamaltdar/Tahsildar, then the Inspector of Police, Vita Police Station, shall decide the said application for grant of police protection, within seven days from the date of receipt of the said application.
