2. In case, the proposal of the petitioner for grant-in-aid(Exhibit -"O", page 61) is pending before the Education Officer, then, the Education Officer shall process the same and forward it to the higher authority. As per the procedure, the authority shall

process further and forward it to the State Government. The State Government shall, thereafter, take decision upon the proposal of the petitioner for grant-in-aid expeditiously and preferably within six months from the date of receipt of the same.

3. The writ petition is disposed of. No costs.
