2. The Applicant preferred Criminal Appeal No. 920 of 2001 which has been disposed of vide judgment and order dated 29th of April, 2022. The Applicant has been convicted for offence under Section 304 Part I. He was directed to surrender to Jail Custody within four weeks.

3. Learned Advocate for Applicant submits that the Applicant is ailing and he was hospitalized for treatment. Subsequently, he was discharged.
