4. The petitioner may apply to the learned Assistant Charity Commissioner/Joint Charity Commissioner for expeditious disposal of the applications. The Assistant Charity Commissioner/Joint Charity Commissioner may

consider the application for expeditious disposal and endeavour to decide the same of course as per the procedure and after hearing of all the parties concerned.

5. The Assistant Charity Commissioner/Joint Charity Commissioner may endeavour to decide the said application if possible within one year.

6. The writ petition is disposed of. No costs.
