2. The applicants / appellants are the unfortunate wife and children of the deceased. By the impugned judgment and award passed by the learned Motor Accident Claim Tribunal, Gadhinglaj in MACP No. 44 of 2014, the trial court has dismissed the claim application of the applicants / appellants.
