2. Leave to amend without need of reverification. Amendments to be carried out in the course of the day today. We dispose of the Petition with a limited relief directing the Divisional Joint Registrar Co-operative Societies Mumbai to hear and dispose of the Revision Application filed by the 2nd Respondent that is pending before him. While doing so the Divisional Joint Registrar will hear the Petitioners who are the original complainants and who obtained an
