. It is an application for condonation of delay moved by the Applicant / Appellant.

2. Heard Mr. Mehul A. Shah, learned counsel for the Applicant and Mr. Prasad Gajbhiye, learned counsel for the Respondent No.2. None present for Respondent No.1 though notice is duly served through Court as well as by way of private mode of service.

3. It appears that there is delay of 32 days in preferring an appeal. Even though, learned counsel for the Respondent No.2 opposed to condone the delay, by looking to the small volume of delay, it is necessary to condone the delay in the interest of justice.

ORDER

(i) The application for condonation of delay is hereby allowed, in terms of prayer clause 7(a).
