1 At the outset, learned A.P.P states that the prosecution has examined 6 witnesses and only 2 witnesses are left to be examined i.e. the Medical Officer and the Investigating Officer.

2 In view of the statement made by the learned A.P.P, learned counsel for the applicant does not press this application. He, however,

requests that the trial Court be directed to conclude the trial as expeditiously as possible and within a particular time-frame.
