1. Mr. Belge, learned Counsel for petitioner No.17, on instructions, seeks leave of the Court to withdraw the petition filed by petitioner No.17.

2. Leave is granted. Petition of petitioner No.17 is disposed of as withdrawn.

3. As regards the remaining petitioners, learned Counsel for these petitioners has presented to the Court consent terms recording settlement which has been arrived at between these petitioners and respondents No.5 and 6. The Consent terms are taken on record and marked "A" for identification.
