Ms. Pathare appearing for petitioner states that on 13<sup>th</sup> March, 2020 this Court had directed appellant to file private paper book within six months from today, with a copy to the other side. be directed to provide a copy thereof. Ms. Pathare states that she will apply during the course of this week. Within two weeks of receiving the application, Registry shall provide a photocopy of the private paper book (not certified copy) to the petitioner.
