In case the said grievance still subsists, we direct the concerned authority to give proper treatment to the petitioner by admitting him in the hospital, if necessary in a good government hospital, as expeditiously as possible, and in any case within three months from today.

3. The other grievances raised in the petition can also be taken care of by the concerned authority within the aforesaid period.

4. With the above observations, writ petition stands disposed of.

5. Registry shall send a copy of this order to the concerned jail authority, who in turn shall communicate the same to the petitioner.
