2. Issue notice to the Respondents. The learned AGP appears by waiving notice of the Respondent Nos. 1,2 and 5. Mr. Shetye, waives for the Respondent No.4.

3. The main relief claimed in the Petition is against the Respondent Nos. 1 and 2. Therefore, we do not think it necessary to

issue any notice to the Respondent No.5. Considering the limited relief claimed in the Petition, the Petition can be disposed of by issuing necessary directions.
