Heard learned Counsel for the Applicant and perused the contents of the application. According to the Applicant his name is

shown in Schedule I of the Public Trust Register and hence he is entitled to represent interest of Respondent No.3 – management. Since the Respondent No.3 has not been deliberately arrayed through the applicant, the Rule as issued on 11th August 2021 be discharged.
