1. By this petition, the petitioners seeks quashing of the F.I.R. bearing C.R. No. 193 of 2019 registered with the Bund Garden Police Station, Pune City, Pune for the alleged offence punishable under Section 420 r/w 34 of the Indian Penal Code.
