In view of the deliberation which took place during the course of arguments, learned senior counsel for the Petitioner, on instructions, submitted that, the Petitioner will deposit a sum of Rs.2 crores 50 lakhs with the Respondent No.1-corporation within a period of 6 months from today. He further submitted that, the Petitioner will deposit a Demand Draft of Rs.28 lakhs with the Respondent No.1-Corporation on or before 10<sup>th</sup> March, 2022. That, aAfter deducting the said amount of Rs.28 lakhs from Rs.2 crores 50 lakhs, the balance amount of Rs.2 crores 22 lakhs will be deposited by the Petitioner within a period of 6 months from today with

the Respondent No.1. He further submitted that, the Authorized Officer and/or the Director of the Petitioner will file an undertaking in that behalf before this Court within a period of two weeks from today. The said statements are accepted.

2 In view of the statements made by the learned senior counsel for the Petitioner, the operative part of the impugned Order dated 29<sup>th</sup> October, 2021 stands modified to that extent.

3 Writ Petition is allowed in the aforesaid terms.
