1. Heard the learned counsel for the applicant-respondent No.1.

2. The learned counsel for the applicant submits that in terms of the order dated 8th April 2022, the applicant has deposited a sum of RS.1,75,000/- with the registry of this Court. While passing the order of suspension of sentence, on 11th September 2018, this Court has directed the applicant to deposit 50% of the compensation amount aggregating to Rs.3,25,000/-. The said

amount has now been paid/deposited.

3. The respondent No.2-complainant is permitted to withdraw the amount of Rs.1,75,000/- deposited by the applicant, on proper identification and furnishing an undertaking that the complainant -respondent No.2 would bring back the said amount, in the event, the applicant succeeds in the revision.

The substantive sentence stands suspended till the hearing of the revision application.

The applicant be released on bail on furnishing P.R. Bond of Rs.15,000/- and surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate.

4. Interim application stands disposed.

5. Revision Application be posted for hearing on 20th June 2022.
