At the outset learned counsel for Respondent No.5 raised a preliminary objection and submitted that, against the impugned Order dated 5th July 2018 passed by the Respondent No.1, an appeal before the Appellate Authority, i.e. Apex Grievance Redressal Committee, is maintainable and without availing the said statutory alternate remedy available at the disposal of the Petitioner, he has directly approached this Court.

2. In view thereof, Mr.Bhanushali, learned counsel for the Petitioner, on instructions, seeks leave to withdraw the present Petition with liberty to file the said statutory appeal before the Apex Grievance Redressal Committee.

Leave and liberty granted.

3. Petition is disposed off as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.

4. It is to be noted here that, the present Petition has been disposed off on the basis of the preliminary objection raised by the learned counsel for the Respondent Nos.5 and this Court has not adjudicated the merits involved in it or arising out of the impugned Order dated 5th July 2018.
