The present petition is filed on the apprehension that, coercive action would be taken against the Petitioners for not passing the TET examination.

2 Though the Division Bench of this Court (Aurangabad Bench) has taken a view that, passing of the TET examination is mandatory, Petitions are filed in the Hon'ble Supreme Court, where the Hon'ble Supreme Court has ordered the parties to maintain *status quo*.

3 That being the position, the apprehension of the Petitioners of termination of service on the ground of not passing the TET

examination at present is not warranted.

4 It is not necessary to keep the Petition pending as the issue will now be governed by the decision of the Supreme Court. Granting liberty to the Petitioners, in case a contingency arises in future, to file a Petition afresh, the Writ Petition is disposed off.
