This is an Application for extension of interim relief granted by Order dated 11th February, 2022 and for direction to the Hon'ble Revenue Minister to hear the Revision filed by Applicant pending before the said Authority.

2. Mr. Patil learned counsel for the Applicant submitted that, in furtherance of Order dated 11th February, 2022, the Applicant has in fact preferred Revision before the concerned Authority, however, due to the

present session of Legislative Assembly, the application for stay could not be taken up.
