1. By this petition, the petitioner seeks quashing of FIR registered vide CR no.96 of 2021, with the Vanrai Police Station (subsequently, transferred to Economic Offence Wing, Mumbai), on the assumption that he has been arraigned as an accused in the said C.R.

2. Learned APP, on instructions of PI Gaikwad attached to

Economic Offence Wing, General Cheating-II states that the petitioner has not been arraigned as an accused in the said CR and that he has been sent a notice under Section 91 of Cr.P.C. to appear before the agency, for production of certain documents.

3. In view of the statement made by the learned APP, on instructions, the question of quashing of FIR does not arise.
