The learned counsel for the parties submit that the parties to the dispute have settled their dispute and have tendered the Consent Terms which are taken on record and marked Exhibit "X" for identification. Consent Terms have been signed by the Assistant

Manager of the Appellant-Insurance Company and by Respondent Nos.1 to 3, who have been identified by their counsel. They have also tendered their photo identification, which have been returned back to them after verification. Appeal is accordingly disposed of in terms of Consent Terms.

2. Court fees be refunded as per Rules.

3. As per the Consent Terms, the amount deposited by the Oriental Insurance Company in this Court is required to be transferred to Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Nasik for disbursement to Respondent Nos.1 to 3. The said amount deposited with the High Court be transferred to Motor Accident Claims Tribunal Nasik in M. A. C. P No. 631 of 1998 within a period of four weeks.

4. The First Appeal is accordingly disposed of in terms of the Consent Terms. Decree be drawn up accordingly. In view of disposal of Appeal, Civil Application does not survive and stands disposed of.
