1] This is an Application with prayer for restoration of the Civil Revision Application, which was dismissed on 2/12/2019.

2] Counsel for the non-applicant submits that from 2019 for about 44 months, arrears are not cleared. Arrears of rent is to the tune of Rs 1.54 lakhs.
