3. This petition can conveniently be disposed of by directing the concerned jail authority to look into the grievance of the petitioner and take an appropriate decision if grievance of the petitioner subsists till date.

4. In view of the above, we direct the concerned jail authority / Superintendent of Nashik Road Central Prison, Nashik to look into the grievance of the petitioner if still subsists and to take an appropriate decision in accordance with law as expeditiously as possible and in any case, within three months from today.

5. With the above observations, writ petition stands disposed of.

6. The Registry shall send a copy of this order to the concerned jail authority, who in turn shall communicate the same to the petitioner in case the petitioner is available in the said jail.
