. We have heard the learned counsel for the Petitioners.

2. According to the learned counsel for the Petitioners, the reply is given by the Respondent Nos.4 and 5 that they have not laid down the transmission lines and the towers. The Respondent Nos.6 and 7 do not have authority. It is not disputed that the work is already completed.
