1] This application is filed by the State for condonation of delay of 84 days in filing the First Appeal against the Judgment and Award dated 31.08.2004 passed by the learned Ad-hoc Additional District Judge, Pune in LAR No.333/1998.

2] I have heard the learned AGP for the applicant-State and perused the averments made in the application.
