1. The Applicant had earlier approached this Court vide Anticipatory Bail Application No.204 of 2022. On 22/01/2022 following order was passed;

“1. After arguing for some time, when I expressed my disinclination to grant relief, the learned counsel for the Applicant prays for unconditional withdrawal of this application.

2. Permission granted. Application is allowed to be withdrawn unconditionally and is disposed of as such.”

2. Again a fresh anticipatory bail application is filed on the ground that the charge-sheet is filed after that order. Instead of surrendering, a fresh application on this ground is filed. While considering the earlier anticipatory bail application, the parties were heard, the material against the Applicant was considered and after I had expressed my disinclination to grant relief, the the application was withdrawn unconditionally.

3. Therefore I do not see any change in merits of the matter. I am not inclined to entertain this application.

4. The application is disposed of.
