1] Applicant is seeking regular bail in C.R. No. 1394 of 2021 registered with Sangola Police Station for the offences punishable under Sections 394, 397, 120-B, 201 427 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

2] Applicant has suffered incarceration for about 10 months. There are no criminal antecedents against the Applicant. The only role attributed to the Applicant is that of informer of the co-accused who have committed offence in question. Nothing incriminating has been recovered from the custody of the Applicant. Applicant as such, is entitled to be released on bail.

3] Applicant is directed to be released on bail in C.R. No. 1394 of 2021 registered with Sangola Police Stations 394, 397, 120-B, 201 427 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code on executing P.R. Bond in the sum of Rs 15000/- with one or more sureties in the like amount. Applicant shall neither influence the witnesses nor tamper with the evidence. Applicant shall attend the trial regularly.

4] Application is accordingly disposed of.
