1. By this petition, preferred under Article 226 of the Constitution of India and under Section 482 of the Criminal Procedure Code, the petitioners seek quashing of the FIR registered vide C.R. No.56 of 2020 with the MIDC Police Station, Mumbai for the alleged offences punishable under Sections 408, 341, 406, 420 and 379 of the Indian Penal Code.

2. Quashing is sought on the premise that the petitioners and the respondent no.2 have amicably settled their dispute.
