1. The applicant and the complainant are present in the Court.

: ORDER :

- (a) Application is allowed.
- (b) In the event of arrest in connection with C.R.No.I-142 of 2022 registered with Mira Road Police Station, applicant-Pawan Laxmi Gopal Singh shall be released on bail on furnishing P.R. Bond to the extent of Rs.25,000/- with one or two sureties in the like amount.
- (c) The applicant shall report to the concerned police station as and when called for.
- (d) The applicant shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing the facts to Court or any Police Officer and shall not tamper with evidence.
