1. By this petition, the petitioners seeks quashing of the FIR bearing C.R. No.I-264 of 2018 registered with the Kalyan Taluka Police Station, Thane Rural, at the behest of the respondent No.2, for the alleged offences punishable under Sections 447, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 r/w 34 of the Indian Penal Code.
